Week 1	N/A	Introductions to GCSE German. Understanding the school system in the UK and in the German-speaking world. Developing reading skills in L2. Week 2	Demonstrate an understanding of timetabling in L2. Begin to use present tense to discuss school activities. Developing listening skills.	Developing translation skills into L2. Be able to give a straightforward opinion using “denn” and “weil”	Write in detail about expectations for the new school year using prompt questions.
Week 3	Describing uniform and how this differs in the UK and German speaking countries. Practise adjectival agreements with colours to describe nouns.	Developing picture descriptions skills. Giving opinions about school uniform. Discussing school rules and being able to write your own rules using modal verbs (darf, muss kann).	
Week 4	Developing receptive skills of listening and reading for GCSE style texts. Giving opinions and justifications on school rules. Discussing word order when using more than one verb in a German sentence	Understanding different types of school events in English and German speaking countries. Developing receptive skills.	Further develop knowledge of the past tense in German. Describing a past school event and giving opinions in the past.
Week 5	<i>Day of German Unity Project. Recognise the cultural importance of the Berlin wall coming down and Germans celebrating the Day of Unity.</i>	<i>Day of Unity Project. Design a piece of art as part of the Berlin wall.</i>	
Week 6	Discussing what a student exchange is and being able to describe school life to an exchange student.	Practice GCSE style writing task. Creating a 80-90 words letter about school life using at least 2 tenses. Improve translation into L2 using structured translation task	Begin to understand how to approach literary text questions at GCSE level. German Grammar Practice about the topic of school.
Week 7	Retrieve and practise receptive skills, GCSE style reading and listening tasks from the topic of school.	Retrieve and practise productive skills, GCSE style speaking and writing tasks from the topic of school.	

Week 8	Learning about German speaking musicians. Developing reading skills in L2.	Describing what activities you like to do in your free time. Using frequency expressions and manipulating word order in L2.	Developing phonetic sounds in L2. Writing a post about favourite hobbies, expressing preferences.
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
