WEEK 11 wc 18 th November	<p>Check that masks are completed. If not, continue and complete application of decoration and embellishment using paint, string and cardboard.</p> <p>Extension: information poster about African masks. Working on coloured A4 then assembling onto A2 sugar paper one team member to add written information, the next to make drawings and the third to add pattern. Collaged cut outs from pattern sheets added by all.</p> <p>If masks project is complete, introduce traditional Australian Aboriginal patterns, symbols and designs used in their Art.</p> <p>Teach use of viewfinders. From a selection of secondary sources, students choose an aboriginal pattern image and make a study from it using a view finder to enlarge a small section to A5 size.</p>
WEEK 12 wc 25 th November	<p>Paint work drawn last lesson with poster paint; flat block colours.</p> <p>Draw a border of aboriginal symbols to frame the painting, keeping these as pencil line drawings.</p>
WEEK 13 wc 2 nd December	<p>Complete painting and drawn border from last lesson.</p>
WEEK 14 wc 9 th December	<p>Select an animal image. Draw then paint A4 on black paper.</p> <p>Meanings of symbolism explored and discussed.</p>
WEEK 15 wc 16 th December	<p>Complete animal paintings begun last lesson.</p>
